## January 3 • Sandy Lockerman Hummingbirds: Jewels of the Air

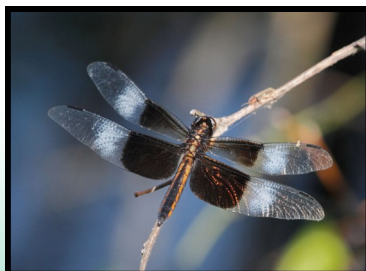
